

# Access to Higher Education Diploma

## School of Health Sciences Entry Requirements

<b>Programme:</b>	<b>BSc (Hons) Orthoptics</b>
<b>GCSE Requirements:</b>	5 GCSEs at Grade C. This must include English Language, Mathematics and a Science subject. (Equivalents are not considered).
<b>Access Requirements:</b>  We consider Access Courses to be suitable for adult learners.  It is required that all applicants attain <b>60 Credits at Level 3</b> . Please note that all 60 Credits should be <b>new learning</b> . It is not acceptable for GCSE awards to be applied against the Diploma.  <b>45 Level 3 Credits</b> must be gained from graded academic modules and passed at <b><u>Distinction</u></b> .	
<b>Subject:</b>	<b>Number of Credits:</b>
Human Biology, Biological Science or Physiology, Maths/Applied Maths, Physics, Topics related to Healthcare/ Psychology	Minimum of 45 Credits total  (To include a minimum of 15 credits in a Biological science or physiology)

Units chosen must be from the academic subjects – either another Science or additional credits from those subjects stipulated above.	15 ungraded
