Access Requirements:

It is required that all applicants attain **60 Credits at Level 3**. Please note that all 60 Credits should be **new learning**. It is not acceptable for GCSE awards to be applied against the Diploma.

45 Level 3 Credits must be gained from graded academic modules and passed at **Distinction**.
