Presentation guidance for Distributed Algorithms interviews

For the applicant

The CDT wants people who are interested in a career in data science, the challenges that arise from complex data problems, and developing solutions that harness the power of future computing.

Please prepare 3-minute presentation explaining your suitability to be part of the CDT, by answering these three questions: -

- 1) Why would you like to do a PhD now?
- 2) What experience have you gained during your academic and professional career to date that makes you feel that you are a suitable candidate for the CDT?
- 3) Why do you want to do this PhD specifically and be part of the CDT?

Your presentation should be no longer than three minutes.

Presentation format

You can either:

- 1. Present your presentation live, in-person at the beginning of your interview; or
- 2. Present a pre-recorded presentation to the panel at the beginning of your interview.

Presenting your video at your interview

Interviews are held on MS Teams. You will be asked to present your video (by sharing your screen) at the beginning of your interview. If you are unfamiliar with sharing your screen on MS Teams please review the guidance found here.
