

## **ORDINANCE 65: Certificate in Industry and Enterprise Tailored Education (XJTLU)**

1. A Certificate in Industry and Enterprise Tailored Education may be awarded to students at XJTLU who have pursued an approved programme of study, as prescribed in the relevant programme specification, for a period of not more than three years, to the satisfaction of the Examiners.
2. A programme of study leading to the Certificate in Industry and Enterprise Tailored Education shall comprise modules offered at XJTLU only, totalling the equivalent of 60 University of Liverpool credits, at FHEQ levels 4 and 5.
3. The Certificate in Industry and Enterprise Tailored Education programme shall be offered in addition to and concurrent with an approved degree programme of study. The Certificate in Industry and Enterprise Tailored Education programme shall only be offered to students who undertake all the years of study for an approved degree programme at XJTLU.
4. The programme specification for the Certificate in Industry and Enterprise Tailored Education shall set out the generic aims, learning outcomes, structure and assessment requirements of the programme. Further details of curricula and assessments shall be provided in the relevant module specifications.
5. The Board of Examiners for the programme shall be empowered to take account of extenuating circumstances affecting students' performance in determining the conditions relating to reassessments, in accordance with XJTLU policies and regulations and XJTLU's Code of Practice on Assessment.
