

Leahurst Equine Hospital services terms and conditions

For use of the peripatetic services: The referring vet is responsible for booking the case, obtaining informed consent, paying Leahurst Equine for the services, and providing technical/nursing support.

Use of specialist equipment will need to be arranged in advance. The medicine specialist service will bring an ultrasound scanner to the appointment when requested.

The orthopaedics specialist service are unable to bring an ultrasound scanner for use in orthopaedic cases– one must be provided by the referring vet clinic.

Specialist equipment (spinal needles, biopsy needles, etc.) can be provided upon request - please speak to a member of our team before your visit if you are unsure as to what may be needed.

Mileage will be charged at £1.50/mile. For use of the out-patient LASER and lameness services:
* Brief one-off site visit required prior to first laser case ** Including 2 blocks, either radiographs or US of one region, and therapeutics (1 intrasynovial injection with triamcinolone; additional intrasynovial injections charged at ½ price). Further imaging/therapy at Leahurst prices
