In these three-hour workshops at the University of Liverpool in semester 1 and at the University of Manchester in semester 2, we are going to present various games ideas that can be used in your language teaching.

We will discuss the purpose that games can serve (e.g. grammar or vocab revision, ice breakers, cohort-building, oral skills etc.). There will be time set aside both for you to try out games selected by us for their effectiveness and for you to contribute your ideas for using games.

At the workshop, we will provide you with an online toolkit in Word with games descriptions and games to print and/or cut out. After the workshop, we will add your games ideas to this document to continue sharing ideas, thus building a games network with you as co-authors. All games descriptions will be in English so that you can use and translate them into other languages. Some will be in French or German as well as in English, ready to use in these target languages.

The Games Workshop is suitable for both University and secondary school teachers who teach levels A1 to C1.
