Students take 30 credits of required modules and 30 credits of optional modules in each semester.

Modules in Pathway A are based on previous language experience and students must meet any pre-requisites. Pathway A modules are typically taken as pairs over two semesters (either ALGY707+ALGY708 or ALGY717+ALGY718). Students taking ALGY707+ALGY708 may also elect to take ALGY727+ALGY728.

Students taking either ALGY707+ALGY708 or ALGY717+ALGY718 are normally expected to take the Group B modules as their remaining option in each semester.

Students not taking any Group A modules are normally expected to take one Group B module, plus one module from Group C, each semester.

The Pathway structures reflect typical student profile. Should a student require a different configuration of modules based on their upskilling or research needs, this will require approval from the Subject Lead.

If students have a research interest involving archaeological method and practice or with an interest that stretches beyond Pharaonic Egypt, either into contemporary cultures of the Near East or the Mediterranean or into the Graeco-Roman period, then they may be permitted to take module options from the broader suite of ACE PGT modules. Any other alternative modules which may be suitable will require approval from the Subject Lead.
