Students take 45 credits of required modules and 15 credits of optional modules in each semester. Both optional modules must belong to the same pathway (either 'archaeology', or 'ancient history' or 'classical studies').

Students may take up to 15 credits of optional cognate modules outside of their degree programme with prior permission of the Subject Lead.

Students taking a programme with an Archaeology pathway will have to opportunity to qualify with a Chartered Institute for Archaeologists (CifA) accreditation. To qualify, students must have taken **ALGY101, ALGY102, ALGY248, ALGY250, ALGY399, ALGY450**, ACE Archaeological Field School assessed in ALGY248, and a further 10 days of fieldwork/employability experience.
