
How to access your ULPF Benefit Statement

Your ULPF statements are accessed through TULIP. From the University's Staff homepage (<u>www.liverpool.ac.uk/staff</u>), click on the link to TULIP:



To view your statement, open Tulip using the link from the <u>Staff Intranet - University of Liverpool</u> and click on the box labelled HR – PDR, Portfolio of Activity, Staff Awards and other personal data.
