Background

Successful applicants will join Tate Liverpool at an exciting time in the gallery's history, as the building undergoes a period of transformation. Tate Liverpool's Albert Dock home is temporarily closed, due to the building redevelopment. During this time, Tate Liverpool has partnered with the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA). Tate Liverpool + RIBA North sees all Tate Liverpool operations (including exhibitions and shop) housed within RIBA North, located on Mann Island.
