Device Accessibility Settings

All devices (mobile phones, tablets, e-readers, laptops and desktop computers) have some accessibility settings. These may differ between handset models and software version.

ANDROID

Access the following adaptations through the Accessibility Menu within Settings **Select to speak**

- Select items on the screen for them to be read out loud.

TalkBack

- Audio describes what you touch and select on the screen

Font size

- Make the text on the screen smaller or larger than default settings

Display size

- Make the items on the screen smaller or larger than default settings

Magnify

- Magnifies the whole screen

APPLE

Access these adaptations through the Accessibility menu within General settings

Voiceover

- Speaks the text in documents and audio describes what appears on screen

Speak selection

- Audio describes text you select on the screen

Speak screen

- Audio describes the contents of the screen

Text size

Make the text on the screen smaller or larger than default settings

Zoom

- Magnifies the whole screen

Invert colours

- Light colours are changed to dark and dark colours are changed to light

Greyscale

- Disables colours

Reduce motion

- Screen effects are changed or disabled

Increase contrast

- Make text more legible, particularly on coloured, transparent backgrounds
