

What can happen to untreated eye conditions?

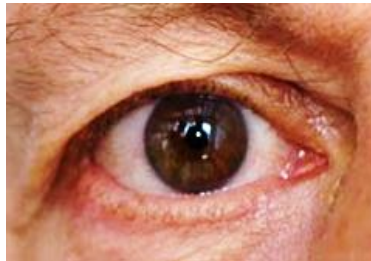
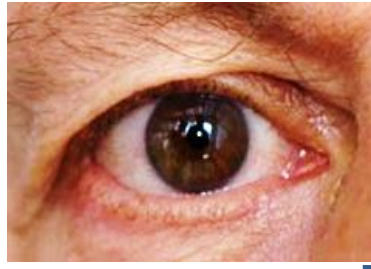
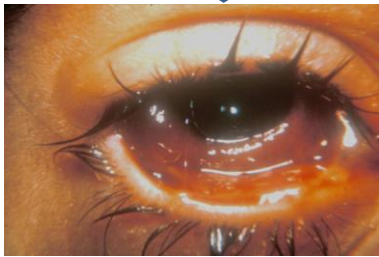
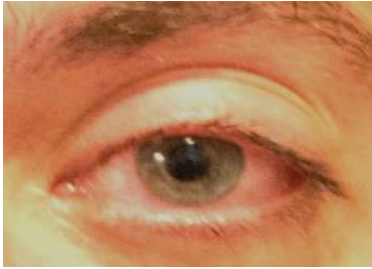
CONJUNCTIVITIS

Inflammation and infection of the front surface of the eye.

GLAUCOMA

High pressure inside the eye damaging the optic nerve.

Remember:

- Reduced vision can have serious consequences,
→ increased risk of falls, unable to work/drive, isolation and depression
- Patients may forget about eye drops or be unable to administer them. These patients will require assistance from family and hospital staff.
- Patients with conditions such as glaucoma may not have any signs or symptoms.
- Taking a short history on admission to the ward can identify these conditions. It is important that any eye treatment continues as normal during hospital stay.
