University of Liverpool's exciting flagship programme allows undergraduate students, from a huge range of departments, the opportunity to spend one year at our joint venture, Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU), following XJTLU's BA China Studies degree classes.

Apart from the [personal self-development and employability benefits](#), the Year in China gives you a unique opportunity to experience life and learning in the Chinese context. You would add an additional year to your degree programme, and would spend this at XJTLU.

The year in China will take place [after you have finished your final year](#) of study. When opting to undertake this additional year of study, your graduation will be delayed until the following December.

XJTLU is a [fully English-speaking university](#), located in Suzhou, approximately 30 minutes from Shanghai by high-speed train. Our special relationship with XJTLU provides a distinctive and invaluable opportunity for our students to gain experience in the world's second largest economy by studying abroad.

During your time at XJTLU you will be studying:

- Chinese language
- Modules from the China Studies catalogue. These can be on any topic, e.g. Chinese history, politics or culture
- 1 further China Studies module or a module related to your degree programme in Liverpool
