REPORTS FROM STANDING COMMITTEES: (Contd)Executive:

- 594 4. EXECUTIVE RECOMMENDATION that Guild Council welcomes the fact that one of the Sabbatical Officers of Guild, as Chairman of the Inter-Halls Committee, will, in future, sit on the Joint Residences Committee.

This was CARRIED. (Nem. Con. 3 Absts)

- 595 5. EXECUTIVE RECOMMENDATION that in view of the fact that the U.G.C. self-balancing arrangements for Halls of Residence financing were introduced after the last grant award, Guild Council calls upon the University actively to support any moves to obtain a further increase in the maintenance grant as soon as possible.

This was CARRIED. (Nem. Con. 3 Absts).

596 The Report was presented by the President and he asked for the following amendment to be noted in his Interim Report of the 15th May, 1972, throughout the Report to delete "trial" and insert "final".

597 The President pointed out that it had not been possible to present a final Report to this Council, the explanation being given in points 1 - 9 of the Interim Report. In addition, he drew members attention to the papers presented by Mr. Colin Lovelace and Mr. I. Picton on Student Participation and that three further papers were due to be presented.
