We would like to encourage you to design a poster on a topic related to EDI and mathematics: from women in mathematics, to LGBTQ+ mathematicians, race equality, mental health or accessibility in mathematics... the topic is your choice! This is an opportunity for you to champion a topic you care about.

- What?** Posters can be submitted in PDF, PNG or JPG format (see the website for more details). They can be an image or have a lot of information, you decide what is the best way to convey your message.
- Who?** The competition is open to all undergraduate and postgraduate students in the Department of Mathematical Sciences. You may participate individually or in a group (of up to five students).
- When?** The period to submit the posters is 3-28 April 2023 (4 weeks). The winners will be announced in an event that will take place in May.
- Why?** We hope you participate because it is fun... but we also have some prizes! The prize for the winning poster is a voucher worth £100, and there are three additional prizes of £50 each.
- Where?** Posters should be submitted using the online form in the website below, which also contains more information on the rules of the competition and some examples of EDI posters.
