Students without formal qualifications (GCSE or A-Level) but with prior knowledge of a language and/or higher levels of linguistic ability on account of heritage, extended periods of residency in a relevant country or similar experience and exposure, may be permitted to take a higher-level language module, subject to agreement of the relevant Subject Lead.
