## Evaluation Criteria

There are 7 evaluation criteria to meet, see below for details and how the submissions will be judged. All videos will be accepted for the Changemaker Challenge and will be reviewed by a panel of experts. All participants will be awarded a Changemaker Challenge Certificate.

The maximum number of points is 21.

<b>Problem understanding and knowledge of IGAP pillars</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Which IGAP pillar does the question relate to?</li><li>• How clear is the problem statement and does it show a depth of understanding?</li></ul>	<p><b>0</b> : Not addressed</p> <p><b>1</b> : Minimal understanding of the issue, lacks clarity and problem statement is ill-defined</p> <p><b>2</b> : The problem statement is relatively clear and understandable</p> <p><b>3</b> : Demonstrates depth of understanding of the problem and the IGAP pillar, clearly defined and easy to understand</p>
<b>Connection to the Global Brain Health Clinical Exchange</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How does the change you've made relate to a previous Global Brain Health Clinical Exchange session?</li></ul>	<p><b>0</b> : Not addressed</p> <p><b>1</b> : Minimal or no connection</p> <p><b>2</b> : Some explanation of link to previous session</p> <p><b>3</b> : Clear description of how change made resulted from learning or discussion related to a previous session</p>

<b>Originality and innovation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Is your entry innovative?</li> <li>● How is it different from others or previous attempts to make change?</li> <li>● What stands out?</li> <li>● Is there a new solution that you implemented?</li> </ul>	<p><b>0</b> : Not addressed</p> <p><b>1</b> : Lacks innovative thinking and originality when compared to other solutions available</p> <p><b>2</b> : Some innovative thinking but may lack originality i.e., overlap with existing solutions</p> <p><b>3</b> : The change expresses strong innovative thinking - either a new solution or strong improvement to existing solution - shows how the current solution differs from others</p>
<b>Significance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What effect will your solution have on your target patient or user group?</li> <li>● How will it benefit them?</li> <li>● Will it be able to help solve that issue? How will you know that your intervention is working as planned?</li> </ul>	<p><b>0</b> : Not addressed</p> <p><b>1</b> : Lacks clear impact or benefit</p> <p><b>2</b> : Impact and benefits as described meet expectations</p> <p><b>3</b> : Appeal, impact, and benefits exceed expectations</p>
<b>Reach</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Who is your target audience?</li> <li>● Is your setting rural or urban?</li> <li>● Who or what community has benefited or been impacted on? Please estimate the number of beneficiaries.</li> <li>● Have you reached a minority group or patients that have difficulty accessing care?</li> <li>● Does your intervention open a door for follow-up changes?</li> </ul>	<p><b>0</b> : Not addressed</p> <p><b>1</b> : Lacks reach when compared to other solutions available</p> <p><b>2</b> : Reasonable reach when compared to other solutions available</p> <p><b>3</b> : The change impacts minority groups or those that have difficulty accessing care provided in the setting</p>

<p><b>Sustainability</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● How have you built legacy into the change?</li> <li>● What ways have you disseminated your change in your country or wider?</li> <li>● Have you produced a website/blog to update others on the progress of your change?</li> <li>● How has the community contributed to sustained outreach?</li> </ul>	<p><b>0</b> : Not addressed</p> <p><b>1</b> : Lacks a clear sustainable approach to ensure legacy of impact</p> <p><b>2</b> : Some sustainable approaches have been considered and implemented</p> <p><b>3</b> : The change shows a strong sustainable approach and legacy has been built into the change and implemented fully</p>
<p><b>Overall presentation</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● How clearly was the problem and solution presented?</li> <li>● Was it well articulated?</li> <li>● Easy to understand?</li> </ul>	<p><b>0</b> : Not addressed</p> <p><b>1</b> : Difficulty in presenting idea, missing elements of presentation</p> <p><b>2</b> : Presentation delivery lacks some clarity and organisation and is moderately creative</p> <p><b>3</b> : Delivery is clear, well organised, and presented in a creative manner</p>
