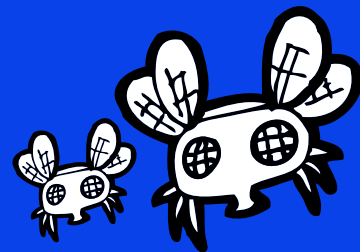


TIME FLIES
