## Psychiatry B - Acute Psychiatry Placement – Y5

During their placement week, students are expected to watch the pre-recorded teaching content that can be accessed via canvas. They will spend the time with the Crisis Resolution and Home Treatment Team and / or the mental health liaison team to gain exposure to acute mental health presentations and the interface between primary and secondary care. This will include 1 long day. Focus will be on acute presentation of psychiatric illness, although students will have exposure to both acute and chronic cases.

Placement minimum requirements: 3 acute case reports (minimum 1), 1 on call, 2 multiprofessional working forms (minimum 1), 1 placement reflection form.

First meeting – Start of Week 1 – 1:1 30 mins per student

- check that the student has received a Trust induction and has submitted their e-portfolio departmental induction checklist
- Signpost to how to access support available and how to report concerns
- Ensure that the student has received appropriate timetables
- Review the student's personal objectives for the placement
- Discuss how they can meet their placement and personal objectives with reference to their timetable of activities e.g. on call, MDTs.
- Recap the evidence the student needs to enter into the portfolio
- Complete the Week One Supervisor box (free text)

End of Placement – End of Week 1 – 1:1 meeting 1 hour per student

• Review the student's progress and the content of their eportfolio for the placement, ensure all necessary forms have been completed and identify key areas for reflection and recommendations for future learning

- Complete the section regarding student placement attendance
- Complete the end of placement summary (free text box)
- Indicate whether the student has met the requirements, and attended and engaged in a professional manner (Complete the placement outcome)
