Why Global Opportunities?

Reports from the Higher Education Funding Council for England (HEFCE) tell us that students who participate in a global opportunity:

- Are more likely to graduate with a 2:1 or First Class degree

Studies of UK and European businesses show that the UK's top employers think that participating in a global opportunity makes graduates more employable, whilst European businesses with international links are looking for graduates who have had some form of international experience.

What will I study at XJTLU?

During your time at XJTLU you will be studying:

- Chinese language
- Modules from the China Studies catalogue.

XJTLU is a fully English-speaking university, located in Suzhou, approximately 30 minutes from Shanghai by high-speed train.
