## **School of Health Sciences Entry Requirements**

Programme:	BSc (Hons) Physiotherapy
GCSE Requirements:	5 GCSEs at Grade C or Level 5. This must include English Language, Mathematics and one pure Science subject. (Equivalents are not considered).

## Acceptable Access to HE Diploma pathways:

Health (eg Health Professions; Health Sciences; Therapy for Health)

Remaining credits should be achieved from ungraded units at Level 3

NB The mandatory unit listed below is essential

It is required that all applicants attain **60 Credits at Level 3**. Please note that all 60 Credits should be **new learning**, ie GCSE awards must not be accredited against the Diploma.

<u>39</u> Level 3 Credits must be gained from graded academic (GA) modules within the pathway, and <u>passed at Distinction</u>, and 6 to be <u>passed at Merit</u>. A minimum of 15 of these 45 level 3 credits **MUST** be from modules relating to Biology or Human physiology. Subjects studied need to include:
