The Built Environment Working Group makes use of academic expertise on campus to look at how environment, sustainability and technology are considered during the implementation of the university Master Plan.

The group will report directly to the Sustainability Board.

Key areas of activity for the group are:

- To be responsible for the implementation of and critical review of SMART BREEAM
- To consider alternative approaches to delivering sustainable buildings and develop a Sustainable Construction & Design Specification
- To develop and review a Sustainable Design Specification
- To monitor and put in place measures to reduce the carbon attributed to capital projects and major refurbishments
- To monitor and put in place measures to reduce the plastic content of capital projects and major refurbishments
- To use the built estate as a living lab for teaching and research
- To seek advice from external organisations when needed
