HONOURS FOR ROB



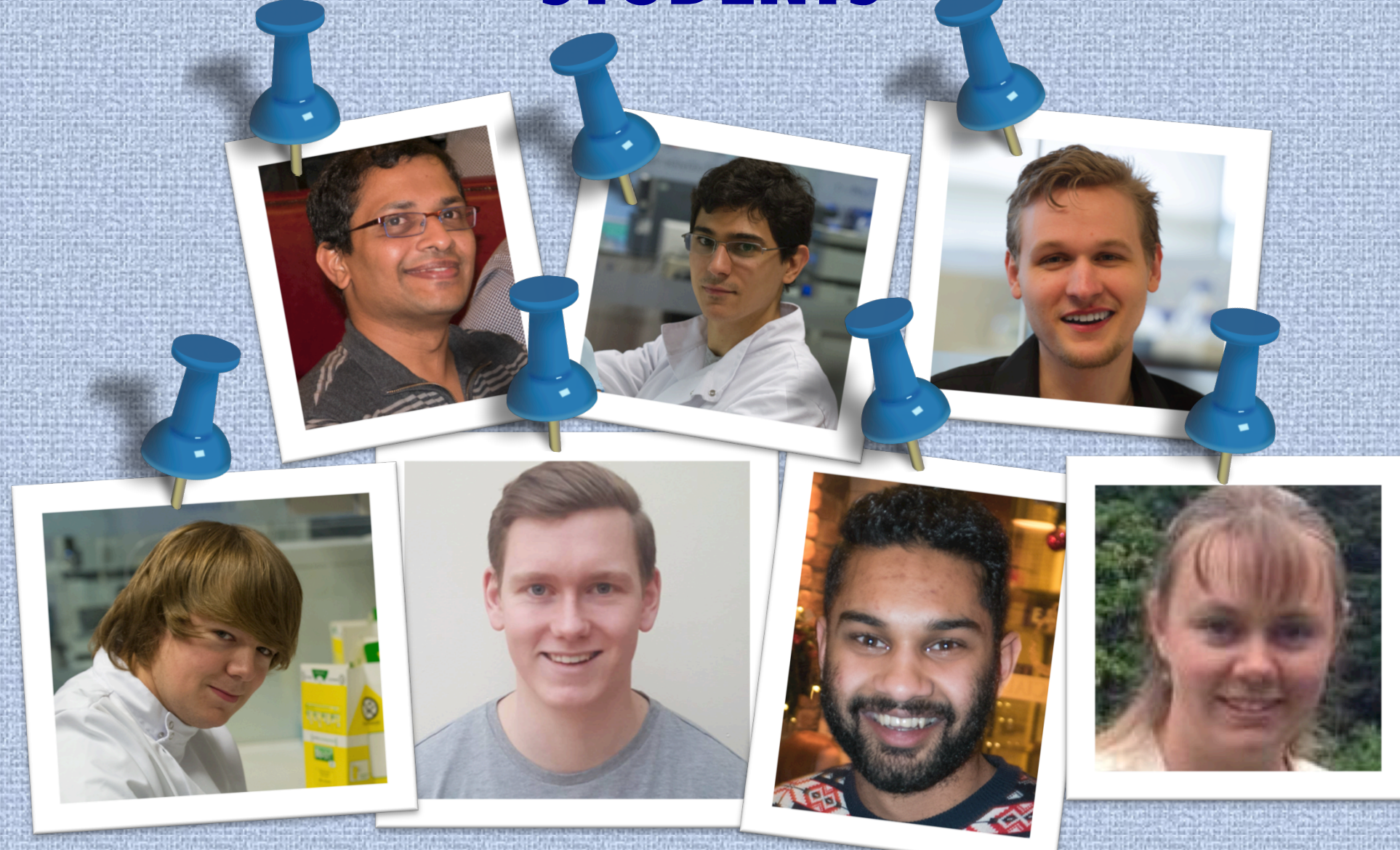
Rob has been elected as a Fellow of the Learned Society of Wales and is the nominated BSPR lecturer of the year for 2016
