

XJTLU 2+2 Applicants

XJTLU 2+2 applicants may be permitted to carry forward up to 10 credits of failed modules (failed Year 2 EAP modules require a 20%-39% mark range in order to be eligible to be carried) to UoL as part of their articulation to UoL programmes. The modules that are eligible to be carried align with XJTLU's Progression Criteria, outlined in the *XJTLU Framework for Undergraduate Degree Programmes*.

Please note that students who fail assessments that include laboratory or practical components will not be permitted to transfer to the University of Liverpool (UoL) in the year they apply for the 2+2 programme. They must first retake and pass the relevant failed modules at XJTLU before becoming eligible to transfer.

After articulation to UoL, 2+2 students will have only one re-assessment opportunity per academic year for any failed XJTLU modules. This re-assessment will take place during the XJTLU August resit/re-assessment period. Students must return to XJTLU to attend the XJTLU resit exams during the XJTLU August resit/re-assessment period.

If all failed assessments are coursework-based, students may be permitted to submit their coursework online via the submission method designated by the module examiner, without needing to return to XJTLU.
