## The Periodic Table at A-Level — Braving the Elements

Professor Matt Rosseinsky

This lecture covers the fundamental concepts of periodicity with examples of how this is reflected in the physical and chemical properties of elements and their compounds. The material is aimed at Sixth Form A-level and AS-level students and is a very useful form of revision for those about to take exams. Full hand-outs will be provided for all who attend. The material in the lecture has been designed to relate to the new AQA syllabus specific actions whilst also offering a unique and stimulating perspective on the subject.

*Professor Matt Rosseinsky read his first degree in Chemistry at St. John's College, Oxford in 1987. He completed his DPhil at Merton College, Oxford in 1990. After two years in Bell Labs, he worked at Oxford University. He took up the new Chair of Inorganic Chemistry at Liverpool in October 1999. This year, he was awarded the Corday-Morgan Medal by the Royal Society of Chemistry. He lives in Liverpool and is married with three children.*
