



EPSRC Funded Postdoctoral Position

Structural Control in Polymeric Materials Via Heterogeneous Polymerisation using Dense Gas Solvents

Applications are invited for an EPSRC funded postdoctoral position to commence in the Chemistry Department of the University of Liverpool in 2001. The duration of the post will be 24 months in the first instance, with the possibility of extension for a further 12 months. The successful applicant will join a new and expanding research team working in this area. You must hold a PhD in Chemistry, and have previous experience in polymer chemistry. Experience in suspension polymerisation, emulsion polymerisation, or supercritical fluids would be an advantage but is not a requirement.
